



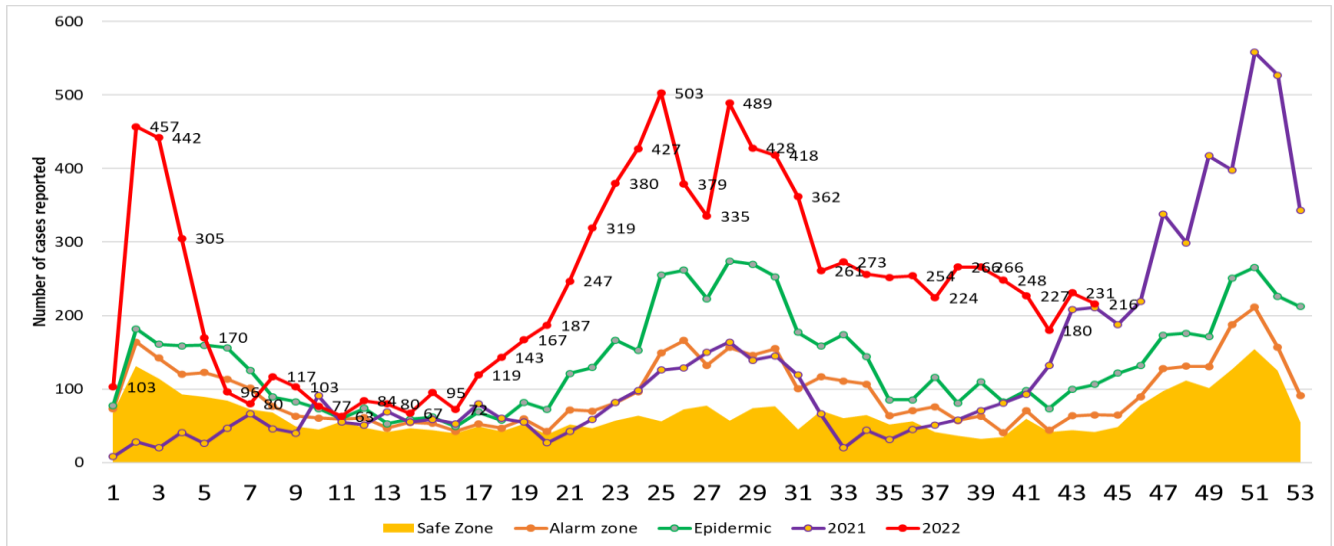

• CASE REPORTING

A total of **10950** dengue-suspected cases were reported within the year 2022 in the Gampaha district. During the **45th week**, **216** suspected dengue cases were reported within the district indicating a **6.5% decrease** in week 44, compared to the previous week.

• Dengue distribution trend - Gampaha district



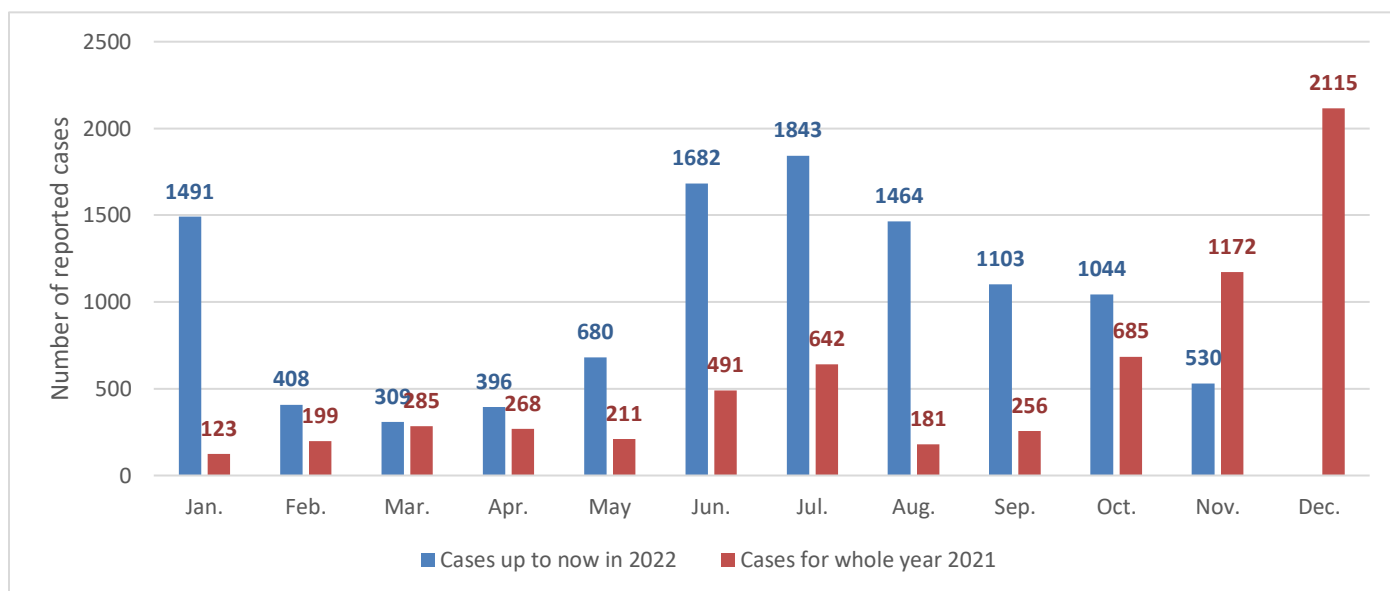
• HIGH-RISK MOH AREAS

Six MOH areas including, MC Negombo (100%), Seeduwa (46%), Ragama (33%), Jaela (33%), Dompe (14%) and Gampaha (18%) denoted an increasing trend during week 44 in the Gampaha district. When considering the suspected case distribution of the last 4 weeks Still Jaela MOH area was identified as the priority high-risk MOH area within the district.
